

**Career Passport Overview** 

## Introduction

A Career Passport is a structured competency development journey to lead you to your next role.

To be enrolled onto a passport, you'll need to be excelling in your current role, displaying our White Star Service values and living our Culture Essentials.

There'll be a series of competencies that you'll be assessed against to measure your knowledge, skills and behaviours within that area. If you feel you need to develop in certain areas before being assessed, you can ask for support from your Line Manager.

## Frequently Asked Questions

### Crew

- What if I go on leave before I finish my career passports journey?
- Your program will stay open and ready for your return, if you move to another ship the programme will follow you.
- When can I expect to get promoted?
- Once you've completed your passport, you'll be placed in the succession pool until a vacancy becomes available, but the passport campaigns are based from demand.
- Can I act up while on my Career Passport Journey?
- Yes, you may have the opportunity to act up.
- How long will it take for me to complete my Career Passport Journey?
- We anticipate Career Passports to take on average 3 months to complete. However, this programme is personal to you, so can be completed quicker by speaking to your line manager and assessor regularly.
